LE: I would hope that people will keep their community in mind and operate from that mindset. That's what I try and do is like, "is this serving my community?" And if it's not, I don't do it. It doesn't necessarily have to be directly serving my community, but I guess the question is, is this going to be detrimental to my community? And if it is, I don't do it. I would hope to see people doing that, I would hope to see people, like I said, speaking from their experiences and letting other people speak from their own experiences. Rather than try and speak on behalf of other groups or people who might hold identities that we don't hold ourselves. I tell people, everybody knows something that other people don't know. Everybody is an expert in something. So if you want to start educating people, if you want to start doing this work, lean into that. Lean into the things that you know that other people don't, lean into the things that you have within yourself, your identity. And how you can present on a topic from a lens that other people might not be able to or from a perspective that other people might not have considered, so that's what I would hope to see if other people are trying to do this work.
